BASIC CONDITIONS

- **Basic BUDGET** will be controlled and managed by the ITTF Education and Training Department and the ITTF URC.
- Suitable candidates are umpires actively involved in officiating duties on the national scene and recognized as responsible individuals by their respective national association.
- Involved NATIONAL Association will have to confirm the availability of the selected umpire and APPROVE as well as CONDUCT initial research/ basic evaluations of the individual candidate.
- The final benefits will include FULL accreditation as UMPIRE for the 2010 YOG with airfare, hospitality and uniform included.
- **The YOG will be held 14-26 of August 2010.**
- A detailed planning will be available for the selected candidates upon confirmation – January 2010.
- All nominations will be subject for a validation process .Responsible for validations within the ITTF is ; Ms Alison Burchell ; Email ; burchell@ittf.com
